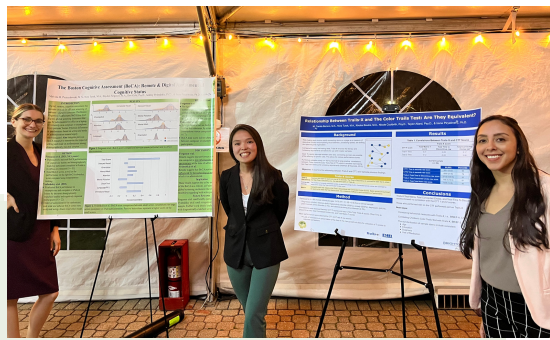
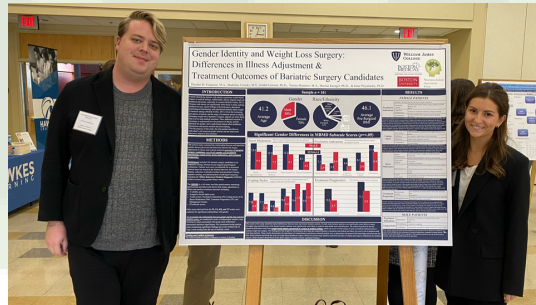


- Multidisciplinary, private clinic in Brighton & Lawrence, Massachusetts

- Emphasis is on diagnosis, assessment, clinical conceptualization, treatment planning, feedback, and therapeutic intervention.
- Close supervision by a neuropsychologist as well as a board-certified neuropsychologist
- Supervision opportunities
- Stipend 1st year: \$56,000

Adult Postdoctoral Fellowship:

- Involvement in multidisciplinary teams and conferences
